As the 1st CoSEEA meeting of the school year 2023-24 is coming up, Allegra Ferrari (S6EN) and Alexandra Georgiou (S7EL) would like to inform you on what exactly CoSEEA is.

What is it?

- CoSEEA (*Conseil Supérieur des Élèves des Écoles Accréditées*) is a Student Union for all Accredited (Type 2 and Type 3) European Schools across Europe.
- It is composed of pupils that have been elected to represent their fellow students' opinions.
- The organisation is made up of two students from each AES (Accredited European School), a Vice President, and a President.

How does it work?

- The presidency organises meetings and conferences up to 4 times a year in selected accredited schools, with the help of the local student reps.
- Each representative expresses the issues, needs, and opinions of their fellow students.
- Then, CoSEEA's Presidency expresses these views at the Joint Teach Committee (which CoSEEA is formally invited to).

What is our mission?

1. Ensure that Accredited European School students have a **voice** in the future of European Baccalaureate education.
2. Maintain the balance and harmonisation of our AES to **unify** our students.
3. Maintain the **quality** of our system in the eyes of our students, by helping/advising Pupil Committees in need.
4. **Organise** and help AES be invited to various events (eg. euronight).
